Employment

Status: Part-time

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. The work schedule varies from week to week and will be determined by the Operations Coordinator, Executive Director or designee. The employee must be available to work weekends.
- 2. Work hours will vary by week
- 3. Employee understands that work hours are scheduled on an "as needed basis" and that there is no minimum guarantee of work hours per week. This job description is not intended to, and does not, create any contractual obligations. Mohican Outdoor School reserves the right to terminate the employee with or without cause, regardless of compliance (or lack thereof) with the terms of this job description.
- 4. Teach day time classes as scheduled.
- 5. Teach evening classes as scheduled.
- 6. Supervise a student table during each meal s/he is on duty.
- 7. Communicate effectively and politely with students and visiting teachers.
- 8. Handle stressful situations in a calm manner and be flexible with students from varied backgrounds.
- 9. Cooperate with Executive Director and designated administrative staff to ensure organized, goal-oriented and successful classes within the written philosophy of the organization.
- 10. Seek professional development and show a continuous interest in self-improvement.
- 11. Know the philosophy, objectives and procedures of Mohican Outdoor School well enough to serve as a representative of Mohican Outdoor School at all times.
- 12. Show a willingness to pursue and accept added responsibility and perform other reasonably assigned duties, adopting the philosophy of "all crew, no passengers".
- 13. Successfully pass a pre-employment drug screen and background check.
